

This depicts the process of making \Winedit a global environment variable. Doing so will make the \Winedit\appenv.bat file known from any directory. "Click":

- Control Panel
- System
- Advanced System Settings
- Environment Variables
- System (or User ) Variables
- Edit Path
- Add **C:\Winedit;** (to the value in the path environment)

Placement within the Path variable can be at the front or back or anywhere after a ;  
The value to add is: **C:\Winedit;**  
I have multiple Windows ID(s) so I updated the System Variables.  
The User variables is the same update process.

If the path value is "long" in length:

- Copy the path contents to notepad
- Edit the \Winedit; into the path value
- Copy the updated value from notepad
- Paste (replacing all of the previous value) the value from the notepad session
